

AJJ2023 AT MEIJI GAKUIN SHIROKANE CAMPUS, DECEMBER 2~3 ACCESS AND CATERING

1. Campus access

The Shirokane campus is accessible from JR Shinagawa, Meguro and Gotanda stations, and several subway stations. Details are here:

Most people come from either Shinagawa station or Meguro station, which are linked by the #93 bus. Whichever direction you come from, the stop is Meiji Gakuin-mae. It's also about a 20~25 minute walk from either of those stations.

Once you reach the campus, head for the main building (*honkan*). The conference will be taking place on the 3rd floor on Saturday and the 4th floor on Sunday. The main building is #1 on the map here:

2. Food

There are no decent restaurants anywhere near the campus. There is a Lawson convenience store opposite the main entrance (were the bus stops), and a FamilyMart opposite the main building, but with a rather wide and dangerous road in between. I recommend that you either bring your own lunch or sign up for a conference bento (¥1,000) when you register.

Light snacks, tea, coffee and soft drinks will be available at the conference and are included in the conference fee.

The Saturday night reception will be a stand-up buffet with eleven varieties of finger food, pizza, and a wide range of alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages. Please register in advance if you wish to attend the reception.
